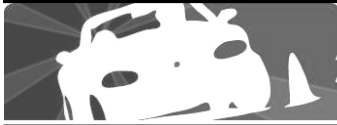

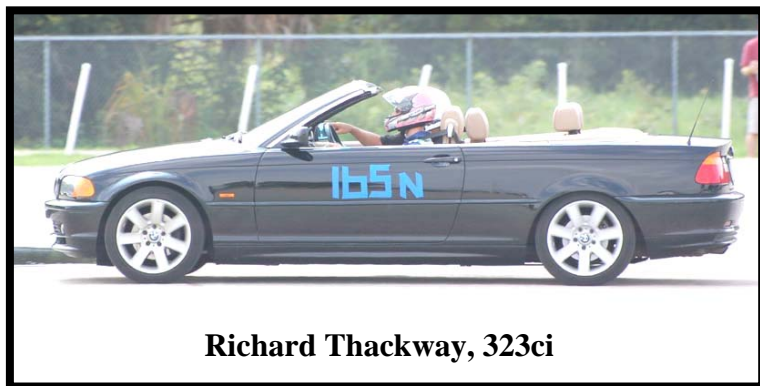

## AUTOX TIPS

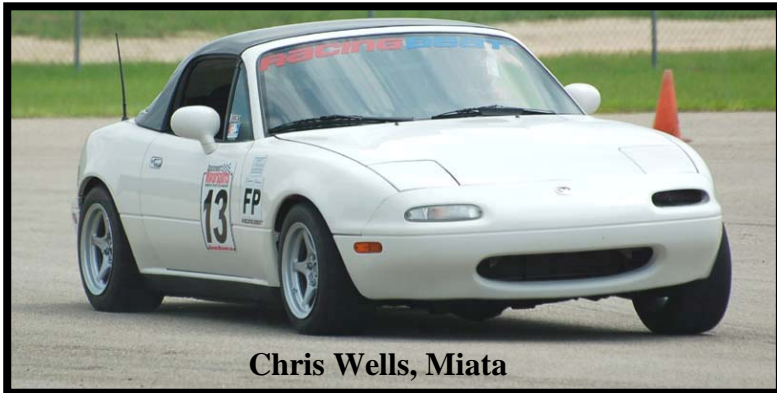
*Just a couple of detailing tips to help you and your car...*

We all know how important it is to see the course clearly, so always make sure your windows are nice and clean. Something that works really well is newspaper. Spray the window with glass cleaner and wipe with crumpled newspaper. This will not leave ink on your window or streaks, plus it will get rid of that foggy film that gets on the inside of windows. Just remember don't use the window cleaner on windows that have been tinted.

Some of us also like to cut the corners a little too close and end up clipping a cone or two. Those cones tend to leave a smudge on your car. An easy way to get rid of that mark is to use a cleaner wax (i.e. Mequiars). Use your finger tip and go perpendicular to the streak of the cone mark. The plastic of the cone should come off quickly.

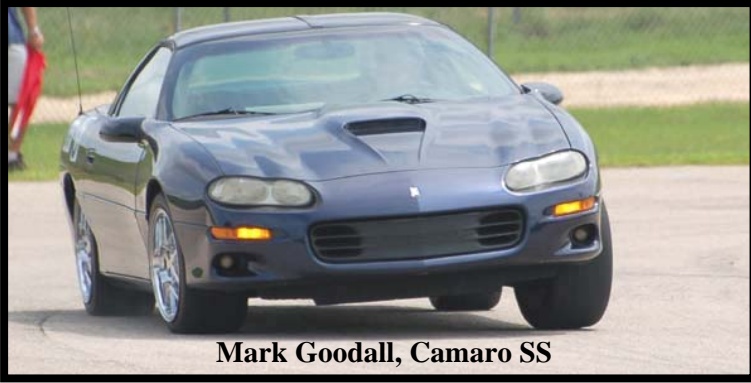

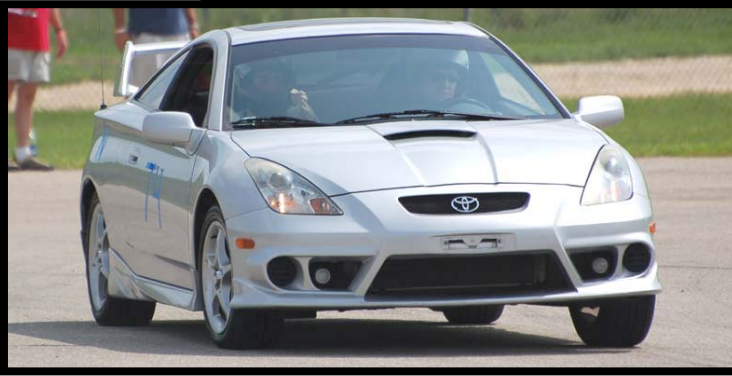

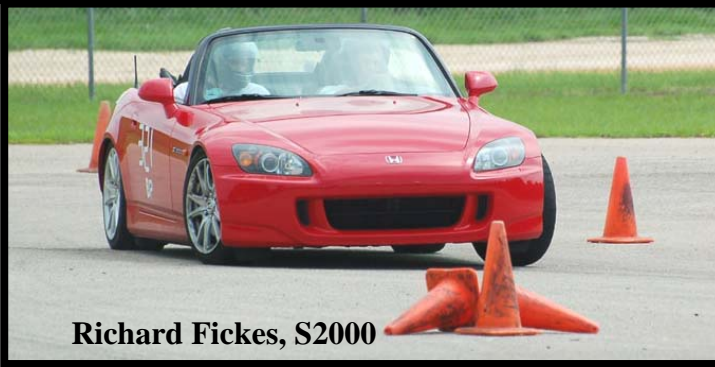

# JULY RACE REPORT

The July event was another typical Florida weather forecast ... rain with a 30% chance of sun. The weather stayed dry through the end of competition, but rumor has it the skies opened up during fun runs. With our normal Race Reporter out attending a Sesame Street cast reunion, I was recruited to write this month's event report.

At the drivers meeting, former President and event host George Bonafede proclaimed there should not be any reason to hit a single cone today. At the end of the day we tallied 23 cones knocked over (one by George in round 1) and 60 off courses during our 387 runs. Eyes up!

Novice was again the largest class, with 12 competitors. Scott Sedlack and Richard Thackway consistently improved over their four runs. Mike Treml had three off courses before putting it together on his last run. With Allen Record and George Murray bouncing around in the class, this allowed Richard's 55.503 on his final run to capture the Novice win.

In the stock classes, GS and HS had seven and five competitors respectively, and there weren't many points to be earned for members in the other stock classes. BS had Nadeem Ahmed take the class win with a 52.550, with Kevin Spence 6/10<sup>th</sup>s behind. Mike Kennedy, David Darrow and Oliver Yao were alone in their respective DS, ES and GTS classes, each showing that they had no competition. John Genduso in GS had the class wrapped up heading into the 4<sup>th</sup> heat, but Walter Christoeffl snuck by him by a mere .015s to take the class win, and jumped 8 places in the Tiger standings. Likewise, Raddy Schatte had HS wrapped up until the 4<sup>th</sup> round when Bradley Collins eeked by him for 1<sup>st</sup> place. Bradley jumped 5 Tiger spots as a result.

In the Prepared classes, Terry Glazar was all by his lonesome in CP. With Leland Giddens moving to MOD1, it looks like Terry has already locked up CP. AP was all Vette's, and John McGill led all the way with a final time of 52.875, bumping him 9 Tiger spots. BP had a bit of musical chair activity. John Ward was ahead by almost 2s at the end of the first round, but suffered a spun bearing. Richard Fickes graciously let John borrow his car only to be beaten by 3s by John. John just needs some fender flares and 315's...

DP also appears to be a single competitor class midway through the season. Although Glenn LaFlamme should have the class locked up, Dat Nguyen snuck through the gates and took the win by 2s. Chuck Lutz was very consistently in the 51.1x range and managed to hold off Gerald Badoz by ~4/10ths in EP.

FP was the busiest Prepared class, and President Chris Wells seems to be up against the ropes. Chris won the first 5 events, and took P3 last month (beaten by last years Rookie of the Year and another unknown rookie from out of town). Last month he beat Bob Blucher by .001s. It looks like Bob took that personally and Bob put up his best time in the first round and never looked back. Chris is still leading the Tiger points chase, but Bob jumped 11 spots. Also in FP, Karel and Travis Schneider continue their alpha male battle in the Schneider family. Travis seems to have Pop's number, winning 5 of the 7 events this year.

I was Dustin Kofahl's sponsor during his rookie season, and you may know Dustin as the guy with that really loud red Impreza. Dustin was having a hard time with Christian Christoeffl in GP through the first three rounds, and finally best Christian by .002s at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup>. Alas it wasn't enough as Christian improved another ½ second in the 4th round, giving P1 to Christian and P2 to Dustin. HP seems to be a see saw. Ben Turner and Jeremy Allers appear to swap P1 and P2 every other month. This month Jeremy eeked by Ben by .030s to take the class win.

Let's see what have I missed, just the karts, right? If you stop by your auto parts

store and find they are out of jack stands, it is most likely due to Chuck Peterson. Chuck has three girls, only two of which race (that's *another* story) karts. SMRT had Mickey Gauldin make a huge improvement the second run, and he went on to beat Dawn Giddens by 3s. Hien Nguyen seems to have Harry Corbin's number whenever Hien shows up, and unfortunately for Harry, Hien did show up. Hien let Harry keep the lead until the 4<sup>th</sup> round, and then Hien pulls off a 49.344 to upset Harry by almost 2s. That is a very impressive time for a street tire.

GTR was the usual suspects again... Jeff MCElyea, Don "Mr. Excitement" Hosler, Randall Huls and myself. My car was just back from reconstructive surgery for the second year in a row. Jeff recently put in road racing brakes and brake ducts. And I think Don has decided to not race the Vette for awhile because he's found parts aren't cheap. Randy was driving on street tires because of the weather forecast. The lead bounced around a few times before settling in my favor. I'd like to see this trend continue...

DR had Jason Young looking for a ride again in a VW Rabbit. Unaccustomed to the higher torque and power steering, Jason was relegated to P2 behind Pedro Castillo. Justin made his best run of 50.464 in the first round and never had to look back.

So that covers another hot and exciting month of action at the Martin Sports Car Club. Bert is already back in town chomping at the bit for next month

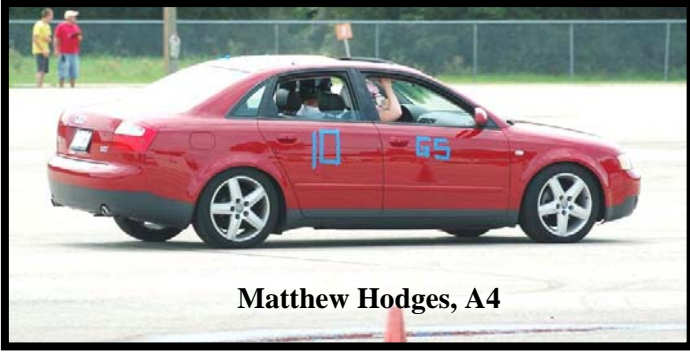
What is that, you say? What about A Race? Did I... whoops, you're right!

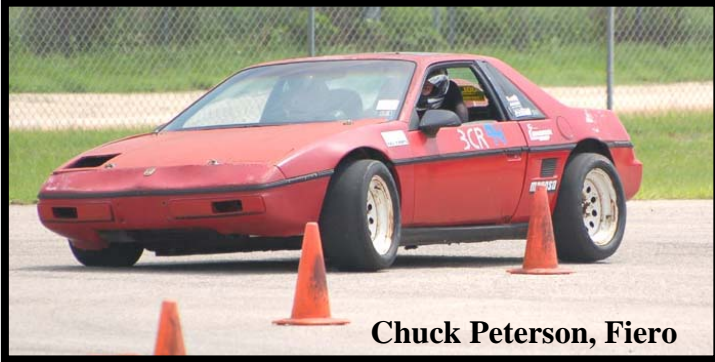
