



RACE REPORT

The Orange County Convention Center hosts a plethora of thrilling events throughout the year – PRI, Central Florida Auto Show, National Federation of the Blind – but none more exciting than the Martin Sports Car Club and its June autocross. This event was many things, including the first event of the year at OCCCCC, the hottest and most humid event of the year, and the most highly attended event thus far in 2013. In fact, the June autocross broke the pattern of steadily dwindling attendance, with a gang of 69 drivers set to light up the parking lot with enough flare for even the NFB to find beautiful. With threatening skies looming over our helmets, the event host team completed feverish course set-up just in time for the earliest of course walkers to begin their course walking.

This month we had just four single-car classes, each won by a driver who beat nobody. The car count was doubled in eight other classes. In B Stock, Don Cross found himself at a crossroads without his course map and posted four OFFs. Mario Knis won by default, but not without posting a respectable 50.754. John and Leland Giddens were back at it again in ASP, this time with Leland emerging with the class win and yet another Top Time of Day, his 4th of the year! The remaining 2-car classes were won by an impressive list of MSCC's fastest and, well, fastest, including Bobby Socks Belvoir, Chris Wells, Mickey Gauldin, Ryan Speaks and Justin Cady.

Novice continues to be the largest class each month, this time fielding 14 drivers. In the final minutes of the day's Novice competition, the class was turned on its head by several drivers who made surprising leaps from zero to hero. Alex Vance and Nick Parnell were early heroes, owning the class with a large gap to the next drivers. Rob Conti and Lemuel Gorion snuck into the mix with their 3rd runs, but it was Carlos Dejesus who took the field by storm and shot into a 3-second lead, having shaved a ginormous 18 seconds off his prior run. Then it was Ronald Aldana rocketing from DFL to 2nd place with his final run after a series of OFFs. Mr. the Jesus took home the class win with his legendary performance, and with it he moves to regular classing.

Super Stock was the class of Corvettes and cones, as all six drivers wheeled a Corvette, and a cone was hit in almost half of the runs made in class. To show you how close this battle was, the top 5 were separated by a mere 1.1 seconds! SS regular Aaron Stogsdill placed 5th, falling just .04 seconds behind Denny Murphy in 4th. Jason Stroud made his first appearance of the year and gave Don Hosler a run for his money, but after coning his first three runs, Jason had to play it safe and fell just 4 tenths from taking all the glory and love from the Love Doctor.

C Stock was in many ways just the opposite of Super Stock. The class featured 6 Miatas, 1 imposter, and a fifth the horsepower. In a

fascinating display of driving skill, all 7 drivers in CS posted clean times, amounting to 100% fewer cones hit than Super Stock. Henry Clark, the lone imposter, used his BRZ's horsepower advantage on this fast, often flat-out course to sneak into 2nd place with his final run, only to be booted down a spot by a devastating two THOUSANDTHS of a second! Myself and Gerardo Bonilla picked up right where we left off from our last event, except this time Gerardo had the lead, and kept it. The margin of victory was just .087 seconds, yet this was not the slimmest MOV we would see on this day!

Kim DeBower did DeWinning again in D Stock, extending a warm 1.641-second welcome back to Bobby Bluché! Meanwhile, Amanda Portoghese and Dawn Giddens continued their cat fight in H Stock. Amanda clawed her way back from early cone trouble to fend off Dawn, but neither could pull on Ben's hair enough to take him down.

When he saw the entry list in SMST2, George Bonafede packed his tire warmers and ran for STX. Simple math told George that winning a 3-car class would yield more Tiger points than potentially falling prey to lan Stewart in SMST2, despite the enormity of the class. And TP is what George is all about, gunning for his 4th Tiger championship in his quest to overtake the world-famous Russell Sink as the all-time mightiest Tiger. And a smart move it was, as George cleaned up STX and collected a pretty payout in TP to pad his points lead.

New dad Richard Thackway has taken a few events off to train his newborn in throttle steering, leaving Kevin Spence as the lone Briton to pilot a German car on Japanese (or French?) tires in STU. Steve Pierce controlled the lead through the first three runs, and word on the street is a small bead of sweat was seen dripping off Kevin's forehead. Must be rumor though, since Kevin was wearing a helmet. Nonetheless, Kevin is cool and calm as The Queen's Guard, and with last-run heroics he pulled off a .4-second win whilst sipping his afternoon tea.

Large car count and close racing are not new to SMST2, which was once again the largest points-paying class of the event, and also gave us the slimmest margin of victory. Wendy Mertz returned to competition after taking a few years off to raise a handful of future autocrossers. Club VP Mikey Eggstorm (it's Scandinavian for badass) lost his brakes during his 3rd run and wisely parked the monster Vette for the day. Chi Ho and lan Stewart turned up in a turbocharged S2000 and opted to dial back the boost to only 345 whp, to make the car quasi-controllable. Travis Schneider had the edge over dad Karel this time, relegating Karel to P3 and putting a dent in his Tiger chase. In the end, lan pulled off a tiny .074 victory over Travis, the closest MOV of the day!

The battle for this year's Tiger Championship is beginning to take shape. See you in July for the next episode!


