RACE REPORT

We have been spending more time at the Orange County Convention Center lately, and why not? The site allows for much higher speeds and more wide open courses. This was in evidence at the July event as some of the faster drivers were hitting speeds upwards of 25 mph, or more! It also allows us to open our arms wider as events at OCCC are more well-attended than our events at Lake County Tech. This will come as a surprise to most of you, but it is hot in the summer in Central Florida, which usually results in our attendance going down as the temperature goes up. Make no mistake, it was hot at the July event, but a fairly constant breeze made the day quite bearable. In all, 72 hot shoes took turns negotiating the north concourse parking lot as quickly as possible. That wide open course made for wide margins of victory.

A total of 22 classes had representation at the July event, with exactly half of those sporting 1 or 2 drivers. Those who had to play it cool all by themselves included Ian Stewart in the Pax class, Nicolas Soriano in DSP, Brian Alburtus in ESP, Sean Monett in STS and Mark Burt in SMF. For those who were with us in April and May of last year you will recall that Mark showed up in a Chevy-powered RX-7; this month he was driving a Chevy HHR – Mark does not do ordinary. In the 2 car classes the theme of wide open was evident as the closest contest was decided by over 0.6 of a second, which is a lot when measuring time to the thousandths of a second. In GS Steve Marcum stood firm against Dave Erecitano, in CP Patrick Barrett out-dueled Jonathan Reielich, in STX George Bonafede sacrificed Carlos Dejesus, in STU Kevin Spence was more ultimate than Steve Pierce and in SSM Mickey Gauldin was more super than Rick Woodley.

The novice class was where it was at. Not only did the novice class have the most drivers by a wide margin, it also boasted the closest competition, with first and second place separated by one thousandth of a second. It does not get closer than that, in autocross terms anyway. Matt Channing finished 5th, just 4 tenths behind Brian Fontenot, who was 6 tenths slower than 3rd place Eric Braun. The battle for first was intense, as Fabian Santos and Matt Santamyers separated themselves from the rest of the field. Fabian led the way all day long, with Matt furiously narrowing the gap, which was 3.5 seconds, then 1.5 seconds, then 1.3 seconds. On his final run Fabian failed to improve but the deficit remained a whopping 1.392 seconds, which is pretty much impossible to overcome. Apparently Matt does not know the meaning of the word impossible as he dropped 1.393 seconds to take the novice class win by the aforementioned one thousandth of a second. Nice work and welcome to wide open classing.

Can you believe there were 23 drivers in the stock classes? Too bad, because it is true! And when was the last time you saw Don Hosler finish last in a 4 car class? Never would be a good guess (but only a guess).

RACE REPORT

Another guess is that he was on old tires. Alan Moore took the guesswork out of SS by winning the class by more than 0.6 over Aaron Stogsdill. Whereas SS was all Corvettes all day long, BS was all over the map, literally, with 3 different continents being represented. When this world wide war was over Mario Knis was the super power in good old American fashion, with Matt Simons 2nd. CS was the 2nd largest open class of the day and was dominated by Miatas - literally, as they made up 75% of the class and took the top 6 spots. All of the action in this class took place at the top, where it should. Vivek Krishna had trouble staying on course and finished 4th, a tenth behind Kevin Bonitz. Meanwhile, Chris Wells and Matt Ferratusco were in full battle mode, with Matt taking the early lead. Interestingly, they both made their fastest run on their 3rd run and finished a mere 0.151 apart, but when the dust settled Matt took the win and a bunch of well-earned Tiger points. In DS Kim DeBower showed why he is the man, finishing over a full second ahead of Steve Shirk. And in HS Ben Turner was the envy of every guy there as he found himself wrestling with a couple of attractive ladies, but Ben has been married for a long time and could not be tempted, as evidenced by the fact that he beat Amanda Portoghese by over 2.4 seconds. Wow!

July is the anniversary of our nation's birth. It is also the anniversary of Leland Giddens' first TTD, which took place July last year. Since then he has finished in the top 3 eight times, with 4 TTDs this year! In that same span John Giddens has recorded 2 TTDs and six top 3's. This is a fast family and July was no different. Head-to-head Leland has had the better of his dad this year and that trend continued as Leland won ASP by just over 0.3 and finished 0.006, that is 6 thousandths, from his 5th TTD of the year. The driving talent in this family is wide.

SMST2 was the largest open class of the day and had a wide distribution of vehicles from all points of the globe. It also witnessed the great spirit of MSCC as the Schneider vehicle (PP cover curse?) had mechanical trouble, prompting Travis Schneider to grab a ride with Steven Hughes and Karel Schneider to hitch a ride with George Bonafede. Mikael Edstrom managed to score a 5th place finish on the cheapest tires he can find for a Corvette, while Peter Lier finished 4th in class but apparently lost a bet with Ian Stewart. Karel drove George's car to a 3rd place showing, while Travis piloted Steve's car to 2nd place. Meanwhile, Steve drove Steve's car to a widely impressive class win by over 1.4 seconds and the maximum amount of Tiger points possible. If Steve were to run with us on a regular basis he would be contending (again) for Tiger champion. Bringing us to SMST4, and all of the guys who pray for rain, but have come up dry lately. There was not a whole lot of drama here as Ryan Speaks lead from the get go, winning the class by over 0.6 and propelling himself to the top of the Tiger standings, again. Oliver Yao finished 2nd and Terry Glazar took 3rd.

And just like that we are 7/11 of the way through the season. The margin for error is growing razor thin and the Tiger battle is wide open. 1
