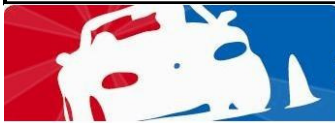

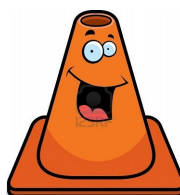

Motion made by **Karel Schneider** and seconded by **Steven Hughes** to approve October general meeting minutes. All approved.

VP Report – Mikael Edstrom

- There were no safety issues at the October or November events.
The October event had 58 drivers with **Ryan Speaks** taking top time of the day

Treasurer – Ben Turner

A detailed income and expense report was given. Members were informed that expenses for the autocross school had not occurred yet, even though the income has been received. Money is still owed to LCTC

Secretary – Mikael Edstrom

Verified that all 26 attendees were checked off the meeting roster.

Events Report – Steve Pierce

November 2nd OCCC Mini Prix event attracted 70 drivers. **Richard Fickes** took top time of day in his CM car, and **John Giddens** was the fastest driver in a fendered car, 3 hundredths behind him.

We have the autocross school on November 17th.

Our pointless event will be held on December the 8th hosted by **Tom McDonald** and **Scott Swartz**.

The Grassroots event was discussed and volunteers were confirmed. The event would only be from lunch until 5pm.

Old Business

- The Banquet will be December 7th, the same day as the Porsche event.
- Evite or some other service will be sent out this coming weekend by Kim Wells.
- The menu for the Banquet held at Errol Country Club, will include Prime Rib, Chicken Marsala, among other foods. The cost to attendees at the Banquet will be \$25. The club will subsidize the rest.
- Reminder was made to bring toys for the Toys-for-Tots drive to the Banquet or the event.

An announcement was made about changes for handing out door prizes and active member shirts at the Banquet. A reminder was made not to sign up for the draw for track days if you do not intend to use them. No one has used any this year, but one person has signed up to use theirs. PBOC has already donated for our Banquet, and a request was made to Chris Wells to contact our other contributors of the track days.

New Business

- A discussion of a trailer purchase took place along with results of trying to find financing. It was decided that there was insufficient money to accomplish it.
- Tax issues were discussed as well as the cost for non-profit status next year.

- A picture of **Kevin Abel** with a plaque given to Chad from Classic Mazda was shown. Classic Mazda sponsored the Florida State Champs by paying for all our t-shirts.
- NASA was also mentioned as a sponsor, and they provided our site at a very reasonable cost.
- The club was approached about hosting a Corvette autocross next August down in Sebring. The workers would be paid but it would be on a Tuesday.

That's it. It's all over. Move along, there is nothing more to see here. In what seemed like the blink of an eye, or 11 months, the 2013 MSCC competition year has come to a close. Close - what an interesting word, particularly in the English language. Read it one way and it means to shut, lock, seal, secure. Read it another way and it means nearby, next to or just out of reach. While the Tiger Points battle came to a close, it was close all year long. The November event was the final event of the year in which Tiger points were awarded, and it was also the 2nd and final Mini Prix of the year. A total of 70 drivers went wide open in the not-so-close quarters of the OCCC parking lot.

The single folks at the Mini Prix were Robby Ronk in ES, Steve Marcum in GS, Brian Rosati in SSP, Kyle Buchanan in CSP, Miles Wilson in DSP, Joel Reeves in ESP, Richard Fickes in CM, Buzz Thompson in STF, Kevin Madyda in STS, Steve Pierce in STU and Manuel Collazo in SM. Meanwhile, the 2-driver classes were not nearly as numerous and saw Aaron Stogsdill defeat Don Hosler in SS, Mario Knis over Salim Ghorayeb in BS (no, really), John "Big Daddy" Giddens over Leland "Lazer" Giddens in ASP and Chris Hammer (awesome name!) pounded Jason Phillips in STX.

CS had a healthy compliment of 5 drivers, though conspicuously absent was Tiger points leader Matt Ferratusco. In Matt's absence Tom McDonald took the win over Raddy Schatte (wait, what? Raddy Schatte in a Mazda Miata? Does Mini know about this?), with Peter Tang 3rd. Matt had a commanding 11 point lead heading into November, will missing this event be enough to knock him off of the top of the Tiger standings? DS had an equally healthy driver count, but much greater vehicle disparity and a much closer battle as Meng Xu finished 1st in a Cadillac ATS, a mere 0.018 ahead of Kim DeBower in a Mini Cooper, with Yang Hu 3rd in the Caddy. FS broke the mold by having only 3 drivers, with Chris Wells taking the win over Travis Turner. HS set things right by sporting another 5-driver class with Ben Turner taking the win over Justin Nordine, with Amanda Portoghese 3rd and you-can-call-me-Al last.

STR was huge, fielding a whopping 9 drivers, 7 of which were in a Honda S2000, but not all in the same car. While the 2 non-S2000's managed to finish in the top 4, they could only manage the 3rd place

finish of Gary Merideth in a Porsche 944 and the 4th place showing of Alexander Herzog in a BMW Z3. You've heard of a race being neck and neck? Well, the battle for 1st place in STR was Nick and Nick, with Nick Bernardo taking the early lead and holding that lead for 2/3 of the day over Nick Sellier. Interestingly, both Nicks made their fastest run in the 5th round, with Mr. Sellier taking the victory by a mere 0.141 over Mr. Bernardo. SSM had a new player from the Wild, Wild West – Jim West, in a Porsche GT3. He and Mickey Gauldin had quite the gun fight, trading the class lead and off course runs and both saving their best for last. In the end Jim was 0.2 quicker and won the gun battle.

SMST2 has been one of the larger classes all year and the November Mini Prix was no exception as 9 drivers duked it out for class supremacy, including the recently returned, new father, Richard Thackway. Speaking of close, you cannot get much closer than the father and son duo of Karel and Travis Schneider. How close? Why, let me tell you. All year long Karel and Travis have finished right behind each other. Literally. They have never finished more than 1 place apart, which is pretty remarkable in a class that averaged more than 7 drivers per race throughout the year. Coming into the November event Karel held a 6-3 lead in those close-but-no-cigar contests all year, but November would be different. Not the outcome, but the placement as Travis finished 4th, which is unusual given that he finished 2nd in 7 of the 9 previous races. Eric Olsen finished 3rd, just 0.3 behind new dad Richard Thackway, who was just 0.3 behind class winner (for the 5th time this year) Karel Schneider, who scored a bunch of Tiger points and put himself in contention for the biggest prize in all of motor sports. Speaking of the biggest prize in all of motor sports, former Tiger champion Ryan Speaks has returned with a vengeance, finding himself in 2nd place in the Tiger standings entering the November event. Ryan did his job, taking the class win by over 1.4 seconds ahead of Drew Hackett, but the class had only 3 drivers, meaning precious few Tiger points were awarded for all of the hard work. Would a small class win, coupled with Matt's absence be the opening that Ryan needed to win another Tiger trophy?

The November event answered quiet a few questions, but also posed a few more. Who will win the Tiger championship for 2013? Come to the awards banquet to find out. All I can tell you is, it will be close, and that is the best way to close the season.
