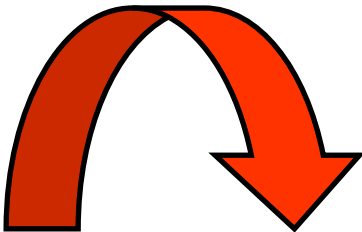

## NOVEMBER RACE REPORT

STU was not the model of close competition as Jesse Olsen finished more than 2.7 seconds ahead of Hasan Schwandes, who was almost a full second ahead of Pete Smith. SMST2 sounded like a BBC comedy, or the opening line of a joke – a Father, Son and a couple of Brits. While the Brits were in a tight battle for 3<sup>rd</sup>, father once again paid the price for teaching son too well as Leland Giddens claimed the victory over dear old dad John Giddens by more than half a second. Couple that with his engagement to Amanda (see above, in case you missed it) and Leland was clearly on a winning streak. 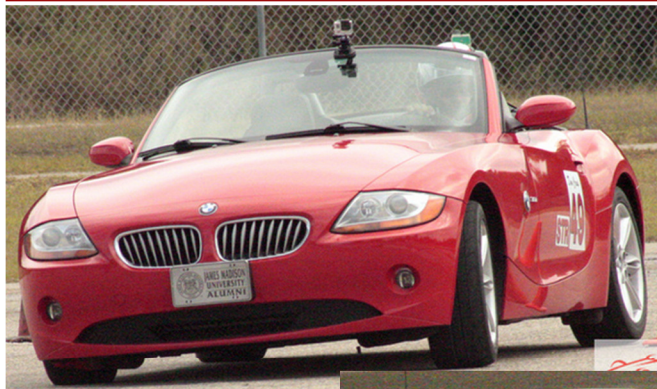

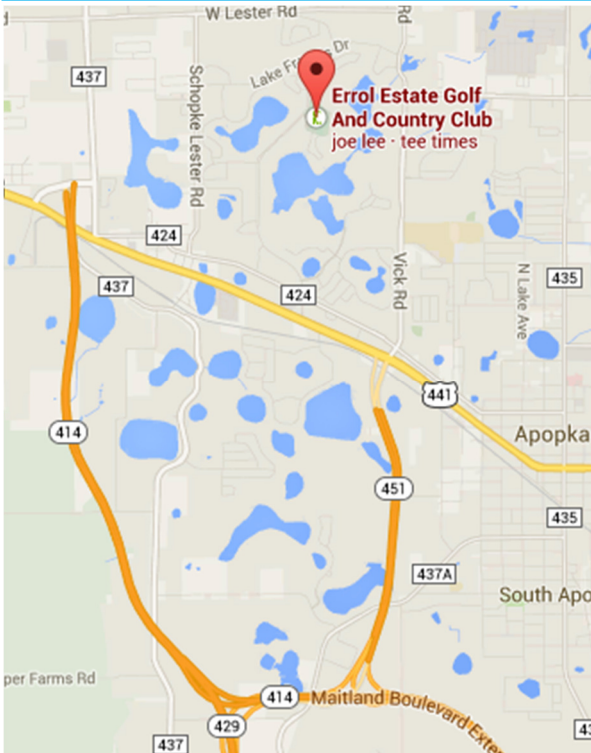

## TIGER POINTS

Where the heck are the Tiger Points?!?!?

Withholding the Tiger Points standings from the Pit Patter at the end of each year is the tiny effort we make to preserve the anticipation of the Awards Banquet.
