

STORY TIME

⇒ Rental Cars

The bane of our lives, being asked to pay extra to secure the car of your dreams or just take what they have, and maybe sweet talk the receptionist into something nice.



It gets worse when you take a trip to Europe, as the 'shopping cars' available are not as great, or as cheap as the standard American type of cars. With a few trips to England recently I managed to have a play in some of the more interesting small cars, and a Vauxhall/Opel Adam. The narrower the car, the faster it can go as it has more road it can use; that's the theory, as long as you love thrashing an engine to within an inch of it's life.

The English roads are great fun, with undulating roads, bends that can tighten and lots of features. Driving well involves using both sides of the road (advanced techniques), when you can to maximise visibility, and observation to see where the road goes and what is the other side of the 'limit of visibility' Key things like telegraph poles, or lines of trees can be used to understand the flow of the road well before you actually see the road.



The Fiat 500 I had one Christmas was great, very chuckable as some of us have seen on track, and great at roundabouts, where maintaining speed to 'maximise progress' was key. My suitcase even fitted in the trunk.

Mini Cooper S, which was a slight upgrade, but this has to be the fastest thing A-B across country (apart from a Scooby). Top fun, go-kart mode was amazing as was the telemetry to a Mini app on your phone. Mighty quick and one could press on across country back roads at up to 130 leptons (like miles an hour, just different:-]) I can highly recommend this car for the handling, dynamics and general ability while also feeling well built. The suitcase had to go on back seat though, due to small trunk.

Now onto the Vauxhall Adam. It's a cute named car and looks quite sporty. All the major things were in the car, apple car play, seats, engine, cup holders. The car itself had black wheels and pretended to be sporty. On the



motorway it did feel a bit 'revvvyyy' and didn't manage to top 110mph, though after 90 it did feel a bit ponderous. Driving the country roads would be fun, I thought. Well, I am not sure if this car was suffering from some strange damage or otherwise, but the car seemed to handle like riding a demented sheep, with three legs. My favourite road is the A422, which goes from the M40, past Stratford and onto Worcester which has every type of bend and many overtaking opportunities, for a good blast.

Taking the Adam to this road was a little precarious. The plucky little car managed to get up to 80-90 and did well, until it got to a corner. Turn in was okay, with little feel, the car would set into the corner and then all feel from the steering would go, so you just had to hang on, pray and check for nothing hard to hit if the car wanted to do something different. This just told me what I suspected that this car is intended for drivers under 25 who like a cute car, but one that won't inspire any confidence to they can go quickly and hurt themselves. So, avoid this car, unless your little ones are requiring a car, which is cute and doesn't want to kill them.

In summary, rental cars are the fastest things on the planet, as they are not your actual car with small ones even more so. But if you want the ultimate small car you cannot beat the Peugeot 205 for fun, from the 90s, it's a legend that had a short wheelbase and lift off oversteer aplenty. Chris Harris agrees, just google 911R v 205.



I'm off to check ebay and see if I can find something more fun for less money than renting.


