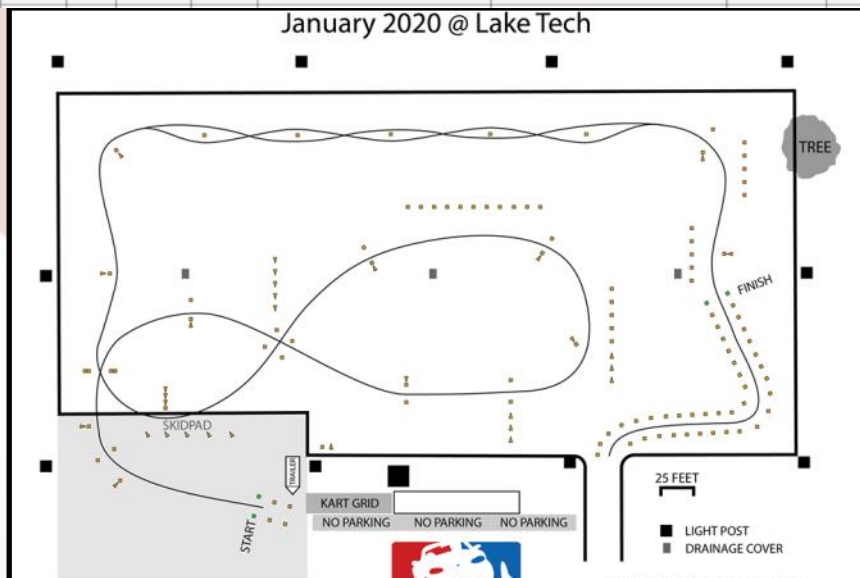

Race Report BY Bob Blucher

Welcome to 2020. This will be a great year for the Martin Sports Car Club as we look to celebrate our 60th Anniversary of killing cones and wearing out tires. The club started off the new year with large turnout of 116 drivers making it clear to see what this year is going to be like. 23 of those 116 were novices, so the sport continues to grow.

There were 8 single car classes with Bill Okeefe (SS) Jeff Retej (FS) Andrew Wong (SMF) James Martnick (SM) Chris Chmelir (DP) Mickey Gauldin (BM) Richard Dybdahl (JA) and Trevor Wells (JB) practicing their skills. The skill Mickey learned was that he should bring gas for his Van Diemen so that he can make all of his runs, but his 35.791 was good enough to win the single car class battle.

The only 2 car class was one that used to be filled with fire breathing AWD Subies and Evos. Still had both manufactures represented by Harry Corbin ('05 STI) and Terry Glazar ('06 Evo IX) with Harry taking the win by .379 with a 34.829 and 5th overall. DS and STU were 3 car classes, with John Walsh using his AWD Focus RS for the win and 3rd overall with a 34.658. Don Cross won STU running a 37.977.

BS, GS, STX, CAM-C, and CAM-T all had four competitors each. Brian Barnett won over Heather Hamill in BS by .692 with Heather holding the lead for the first 3 runs, but Brian ran a 36.547 to secure the win. Jack Gibson ran a 37.703 and won over Zac Saubert by .210 each driving their own GS Focus ST's. STX was won by Jeremiah Hemphill in a '05 Mini Cooper with a 37.268. The CAM-C Mustang of Timothy Engle proved again that sometimes a smaller car is better at autocross than a boat. That boat captain is Juney Thompson and his '09 G8, which was .912 slower than Timothy's 36.679. In CAM-T the father and son of Team Soto battled each other for the win and Robert came out on top with a 40.078 over Darius by .625

Continuing with the CAM classes, S had five, four Vettes and one Factory Five Roadster. Ian Stewart was the class of the field winning by 3.170 and spending most of his time sideways. He ran a 34.443 which was almost good enough for TTD, but missed that by a half a second and finished second overall. Top Time of Day went to the winner of SMST2, a 9 car class, a class that could produce 2020's Tiger of the Year. Robert Palmblad had his '08 Miata on rails running the only time in the 33's with a 33.890, almost a full second ahead of second place Leland Giddens.

The remainder of the Street classes had six or more filling out the roster. AS was a battle between Porsches and Corvettes. The small displacement 2.0L turbo base 718 Boxster triumphed over the larger displacement cars with yours truly running a 34.677, good enough for 4th overall. Adam Severinsen drove a 2017 Cayman S to second place, .320 behind, with Dan Mulchi 3rd in a 2014 Corvette. CS completely belonged to Dat Nguyen and his 2019 MX-5 beating second place Don Wright in his '06 Z4 by 1.4 seconds with a 35.388. ES and 2019 Tiger Champion Trevor Renson was a no show for this event, but Mark Burt brought out his MR2 to start the year with a win, beating Chris Wells in a '04 Mazdaspeed Miata by .579. Mark beat a field of 6 Miatas and one lone 944 with a time of 36.045.

STS was another class full of Miatas, of course, and Honda Insight. Matt Bradford and Nate Adair were the class of the field in Matt's Miata. Matt's first run was his fastest and it proved to be his downfall as Nate put it all together on his last run to pull out a win by .248 running a 36.438. STR was another big class with 9 cars legal for the class. Adam Arencibia-Moore had his work cutout for him today as the class looks to be strong again for 2020. Adam and second place finisher Kyle Shader both made their fastest runs the 3rd time they hit the course. Adam's 35.660 was .033 faster than Kyle. Brian Sewell finished 3rd another .5 back from Kyle.

The biggest class, as I said in the beginning, was the Novice class, split up between all three heats. The winner, and no longer a novice, was Parker Satchfield in a 99 Miata with a 38.493. Second place was Jon Nadler in an S2000, .5 seconds back and in the same car in third was Stephen Simon, another .2 behind Jon.

All in all, a great day of racing. Perfect weather, a great course design, very well organized and run by the hosts and 2020 Board. Remember to make sure your car is legal for the class you are running in and everyone should be policing their own classes to make sure everyone belongs there. Failure to do this could mean winning or losing a championship at the end of the year. Happy Racing in 2020!
