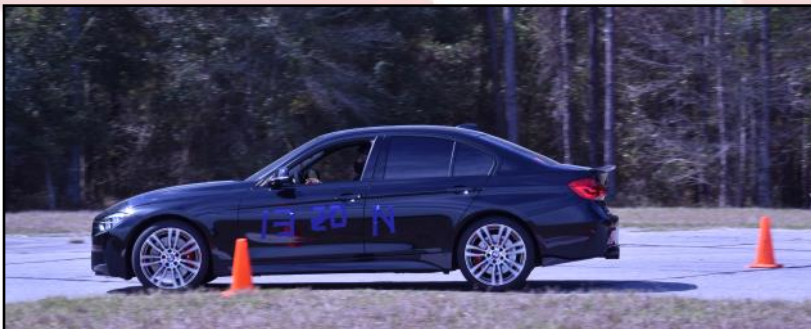

Race Report BY Bob Blucher

The March event took place at the FIRM with 99 competitors making the drive to Stark, FL. The course design was fast and flowing, running in a counterclockwise direction around the track. It was also the first day of daylight-saving time, which meant we had to get up earlier on Sunday, but also had an extra hour to clean up before it got dark. We didn't need it as the trailer was loaded and ready to travel at 4:00.

SMST2 and Novice tried to rule the day just with their numbers, each having nine cars competing. The fastest novice was Zeliang Chen winning by almost 3 seconds with a time of 65.810. Good enough for 54th overall. No more novice for you! Second went to Alejandro Estrella, 68.610 and third to Timothy Schurring, 69.353. SMST2 was a battle of trying to get a clean run with the top four cars hitting cones on at least one run...or more. Philip Russell (S2000) finished 4th, 62.189. Leland and John Giddens brought out their '93 RX7 hoping to stop Robert Palmblad's winning ways. It wasn't going to happen though as Robert's only clean run out of 5 was good enough for 1st with a 58.977 and 3rd overall. *Leland finished 2nd .430 behind Robert with a 59.407 and John 3rd another 1.980 behind with a 61.387.*

Both ES and GS had classes of eight. Mark Burt ('03 Spider) led the way in ES running a 60.089, 1.5 seconds ahead of Chris Wells ('04 Mazdaspeed Miata) 61.633, with 3rd going to Phil Currin ('05 Spider) 63.708. The GS competitors saw Josh Wheeler ('19 Civic) take the lead on the first run and never look back winning with a 60.531. Codriving with Josh, Donnie Lowe took the Civic to 2nd, 62.436, over 3rd place finisher Zachary Blumer ('15 GTI) 63.614.

CS had seven drivers doing battle, but only two were in the hunt for the win. Dat Nguyen and Ken Marion, both driving their own '19 MX-5's, even swapping cars for a run, were the ones to watch, finishing more than 4 seconds over 3rd place. Dat held the lead until the 5th runs when Ken put down a 60.529 to beat Dat by .210.

There were six cars in AS where Bob Blucher took the win in his '17 Boxster, running a 58.536, good enough for 2nd overall. Dean Cook ('17 Camaro) took second with a 62.401. *STR had six cars as well. Adam Arencibia-Moore ('16 MX-5) and Kevin Madyda ('99 Miata) took the two available trophies with Adam running a 62.271 to Kevin's 62.506. Both put on a great battle and saved their best runs for last.*

There were two classes with five cars each. STH and CAM-C. STH trophy winners Cody Mountjoy ('18 Fiesta ST) and Kurt Fernandes ('16 GTI) finished to within .285 of each other on their 4th runs. Cody took the win with a 62.991 to Kurt's 63.276. CAM-C had another good race between Bryan Kelsey ('11 Camaro) and Tom Neubeck ('19 Camaro) both running their fastest times on the 4th runs as well. The winning margin of .320 went to Bryan, 62.300, to Tom's 62.620.

STS and SMF had four cars each. Nate Adair took the win in STS over car owner/codriver Matt Bradford ('97 Miata). Nate took a very close win by just .19 with a 63.287 to Matt's 63.477.
