

iRacing Race Report By Bob Blucher

As many of you may have heard our past president Zane Plumley is deep into iRacing with his ZP Motorsports team. Through the help of his sponsor ICON Sim Sports, Zane has put together a MSCC road racing series for drivers that are currently participating on iRacing or want to be involved in eSport. I won't go into all of the details because I'm sure most of you have either heard about it during a meeting or seen the announcements and post-race videos on Facebook. Let us just focus on the latest race.

The latest race took place at Okayama International Circuit located in Mimasaka, Okayama Prefecture, Japan. The track is a challenging 11 turn, 2.3 mile technical track. The session included a 20 minute practice, 2 lap qualifying, and a 20 lap race. All drivers are using a 2016 Mazda ND Miata Cup with the baseline setup, no tuning allowed.

Practice was led by Jesse Olsen, a Georgia resident, with a 1:49.653 followed closely by Trevor Renson, 1:49.703 and Justin Cady, 1:49.768. The remainder of the field was in the 50's and 51's.

In Qualifying Jesse continued the fast pace by running a 1:49.157, Trevor a 1:49.235 and Justin a 1:49.382. Clearly the race for first was going to be among those three, and for good reason - they are considered Pros and not in the battle for the MSCC Championship. The rest of the field was 1.2 seconds behind. MSCC's own Juney Thompson has come up to speed quickly and qualified 4th just .001 seconds ahead of Justin Hall's 1:50.597. Yours truly ended up 8th with a 1:50.798, .160 faster than Zane in 9th. A little further back was Eric Leitzke, 10th, Maykel Cabrera, 12th, and Chris Wells who had an issue during his two Q runs and ended up last. He would not be there for long.

So, with me being a true iRacing rookie I have not learned (or remembered) all the tricks, like clicking the grid button during the countdown timer. By clicking this button you actually grid for the race, if not you end up starting from the pits. I got this right in my first race but forgot what to do for this one. There you go Chris, you are no longer last!

After a very short pace lap the green flag dropped and the race was on. It did not take long for the action to start. There was contact between Juney and Skyler Gragg leaving a dent in rear of Juney's Miata going into the first corner. Jesse takes the lead with Justin C and Trevor following.

At the start of lap 2 Eric L misses his braking point going into T1 and runs off the track losing 5 spots. Lap 2 was about to get more exciting for the back of the pack. Skyler was leading the pack through T7 with Richard Dybdahl following close behind; they made it with no issues. The next car driven by Bradley Davis ran wide off the track, spinning after he came back onto the track. Zane was next and got tapped by Maykel sending Zane spinning to the inside of the corner and into the tire wall. Maykel is then hit in the rear by Eric L sending him into the outside tire wall. Chris came through next just missing Maykel's front end by inches as he came back onto the track. There were Miatas all over the place. By the time I got there everyone was pointed the right direction and I was able to pass a couple cars as did Andrew Welch.

Meanwhile Jesse was still leading over Justin C and Trevor. Juney and Justin H were hanging in there just a few seconds back from the leaders. Lap 5 I got by Andrew for 9^{th} as the rest of the field held steady.

In lap 6 Justin C starts to put pressure on Jesse as Trevor has the best seat to watch and wait for the two leaders to tangle. Justin H drafts by Juney taking over the 4th position going through T1. Juney gets a great run out of T4 onto the long back straight and pulls alongside Justin H going into T5 (a tight 180 righthand turn) but Hall fights back getting a better run from the outside of the corner and maintains the position. Just in front of them exiting T6 both leaders run wide, track right. Jesse spins to the left then back across to the outside of the track which unfortunately for J Cady was right across the nose of his Miata taking both out of the lead. Trevor's patience paid off as he cruised into a commanding lead. Justin managed to recover to keep second while Jesse headed to the pits for repairs. On lap 7 Skyler had the same issue as the leader the previous lap running wide exiting T6 allowing Maykel, now a lap down, and Chris to get by.

The end of lap 9 sees Eric get past Zane in his damaged car for 10^{th} . I passed Skyler for 8^{th} going into T1, but lost the position running off of the track at T8. On lap 13 I got back by Skyler for 7^{th} but that would not last long, as after being under pressure from Chris for several laps, Maykel spins to the inside of the track coming out of T1.

Maykel recovers slowly after nosing his Miata into the tires and ends up directly in front of me and Skyler still having our battle over 7th place. Not knowing which line into T4 Maykel was going to take, I stayed directly behind the Miata looking for a passing opportunity when Maykel slowed coming out of T3. I unfortunately touched the back of the Miata sending it into a series of tank slappers, finally spinning to the inside of T4. I spun to the inside trying to not take Skyler out and run into Maykel again. Thankfully without much damage. Andrew passes me as I get back onto the track. On lap 14 I finally get back by Andrew and keep the position.

On lap 15 Trevor held a commanding lead over Justin C who maintained a slight advantage over Justin H. This would turn out to be the battle of the Justin's. Juney is now in a very lonely 4^{th} with Richard 5^{th} and Chris now in 6^{th} .

On lap 19 the Justin's battle is finally taken by Justin, Hall that is, by getting a better run through T4 and completing the pass before reaching T5. They continued their fight all the way to the checkered flag, just .167 between them at the line.

Congratulations to Trevor on the win, 5.3 seconds ahead of 2^{nd} . Also to Juney for a very consistent run to 4^{th} and to Chris for a clean run all the way to 6^{th} from last. I ended up where I qualified in 8^{th} , before starting from the pits.

All in all, what a blast we had. A BIG THANK YOU to Zane for putting in the work setting up the MSCC iRacing series, I'm looking forward to the next. We still have one more 25 lap race at Laguna Seca. I won't forget to grid this time.
