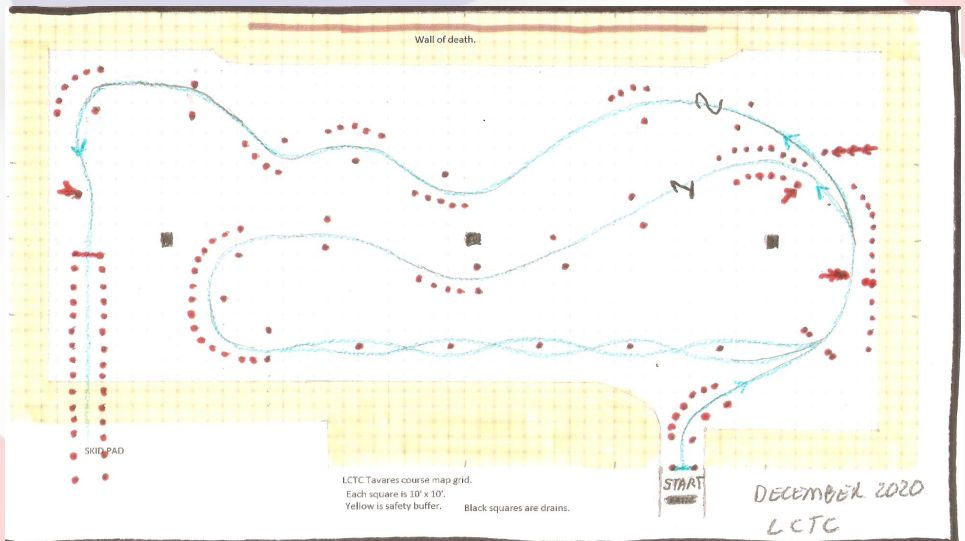

- In CAM-T, Lorenzo Barragan showed up with a beautiful new set of wheels on his 1976 Firebird, which is apparently all he needed to jump top of the CAM-T time charts! Sploosh was driven by no less than 4 people in XP – each one of them taking their top time while driving this monster. Erik Mayer and I officially co-drove it, while Adam took one more spin for old times sake – beating both Erik and my times (jerk). And then Mark Burt took the wheel and set the best time in XP in it.
