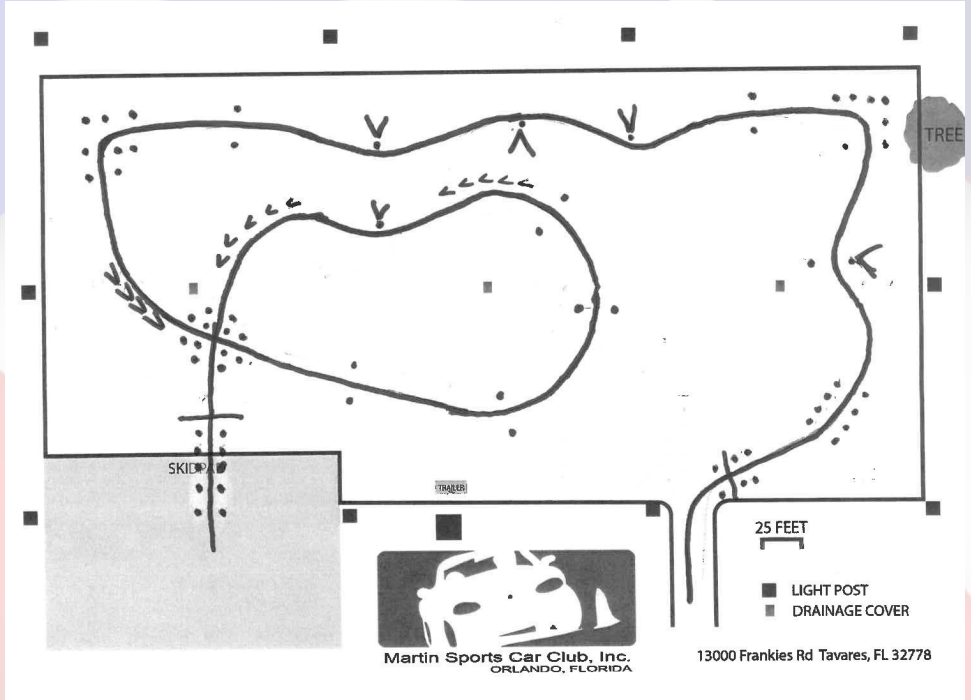

What year did you start racing?

Started racing go-karts in 1996, didn't get talked into autocross until 2012.

How did you get into autocrossing?

Building my RX7 to road race and Steve from Performance Tire talked me into bringing the car out. Ran my first auto cross on April 1, 2012.

How many years have you been with the club?

Ran about a year and a half back in 2012, then started again November 2018.

What is your most memorable moment as a driver?

In autocross, going to Dixie last March and winning ES in the Mr.2.

In road racing, sitting in the post race interview room at Road America after a 2004 National Skip Barber race, with current Indy and F1 drivers at the same table

What car are you currently racing?

C6 Corvette, C5ish Corvette, RX7, and MR2. Not necessarily in that order.
