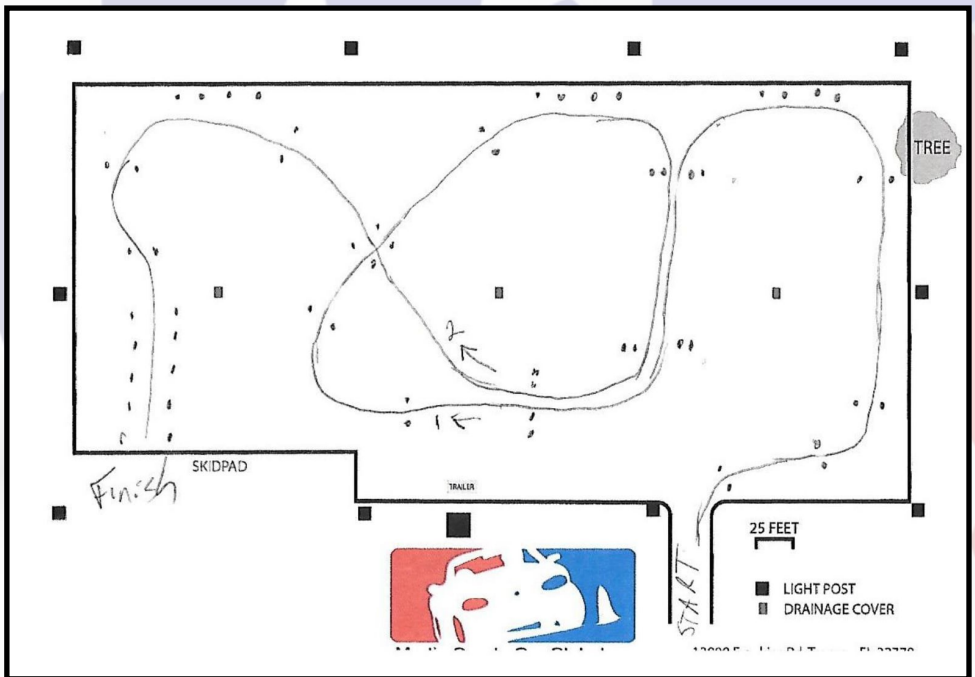

# Race Report BY Juney Thompson

Sweet, sweet November. This is prime Florida time (Hey, I just made a rhyme!). We can enjoy at least 3 days of the 10 days of Florida winter. Thanksgiving is right around the corner. And, we have reached the final event of the Martin Sports Car Club season! Read on for a comfortable, stuffing-filled, final battle documenting version of the RACE REPORT.

As a change to the norm, this season ending event took place at... Not the FIRM! Nope, this time we were at our Home Sweet Home - Lake Tech! The weather was... the best. Maybe ever. It was cool in the morning and then warmed up to a very pleasant, yet still cool-ish temperature throughout the day.

The course was designed by our CAMC boys - Timothy Engle, Kevin Stanaland, and Scott McGlone! The course was a higher speed course (for Lake Tech) that contained a solid amount of steady-state cornering. The course also allowed plenty of room for different lines, if one so choiced. All of the folks I spoke with really enjoyed the course, but surprisingly, some found it to be trickier than it looked. Two of the reasons were not so much course related but surface and weather related. - BUT... Dan did not get Top PAX. That award went to the Central Florida autocross wildman (and body roll King) Mr. Philip Petrie! Philip was driving a borrowed NB Miata and muscled it to the ES win along with that Top PAX spot.

- Speaking of ES, it stands to mention that Don Wright ran a very close second place in his MR2. And that MR2 used to belong to the person that ran third - 2020 Tiger Champion Mark Burt!! What?!! Mark didn't win something!?! Has the whole world gone crazy?!

- Anywho, in ES on steroids - STR - Adam Arencibia-Moore took the win in Tracy Smith's Boxster S. Erik Mayer gave him a good fight, though; only falling short by 0.211 seconds! Tracy fought through the pain of having his co-driver outrun him and he was able to nail a clutch final run that jumped him from 4th to 3rd by 0.004 seconds!!
