In Novice, Jared Ward put down a sweet third run to take the class win by 0.950 seconds! Congratulations, Jared, and welcome to regular classing!!!

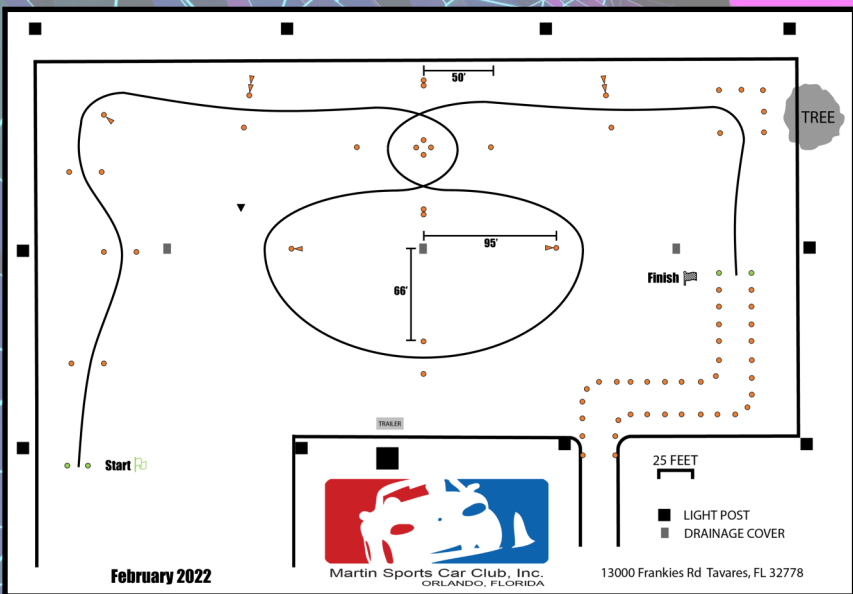
Back to Winning Ways: Gene Van Glahn returned with a slick-looking Bimmer M240 and took a convincing win in FS!

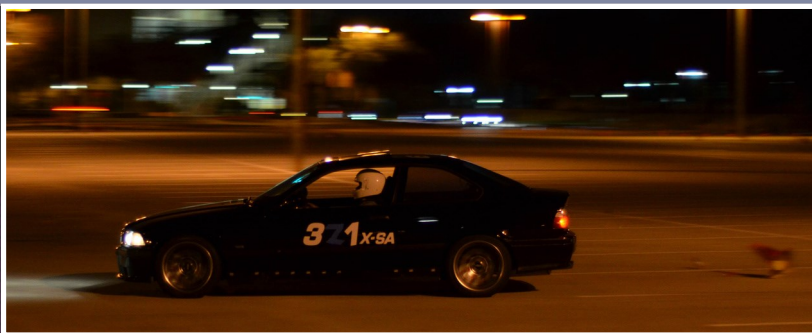
