# August 21<sup>st</sup> Race Report

August. A month named after the famous singer, August Alsina. It's also a month in which Florida's weather tends to get more weathery. For this month's autocross, did we get weathered? Read on to find out weather (lol) or not we did in this month's Race Report!

Our August location was our special locale – the Orange County Convention Center, North Concourse parking lot. It's always a fan favorite and draws in a big crowd. For this event, we ended up with nearly 130 entries and 114 that actually showed. The weather... wait for it... held off!! Sure, it was hot and all, but the very dark rain clouds that came towards us in the afternoon somehow stayed just offsite. It was an August miracle!

The course was designed by our own El Presidente, Mr. Chris Wells! It was a fun and flowy course that took up roughly 0.42 miles of real estate and had a great mix of everything. One COULD say it was a horsepower course by looking at the Raw Times, but I say there's nothing wrong with that! Either way, it was well liked by everyone this reporter spoke with.

And here are some points to ponder:

- The 1st heat battle was a big one! Our top four fastest fellas fought ferociously for the top finishing spot in the final standings! After the dust settled, it was Leland Giddens and the Caterham that took TTD by... wait for it again... 0.945 seconds! And that gap was to John Giddens, who was also driving the Caterham!! John had a 0.907 gap to third place, Robert Palmblad, who was driving his monster Miata and only topped Ian Stewart and his C5 beast machine by 0.093 seconds! So yeah, them Giddens boys had it figured out – especially Leland.
- Top PAX went to a new winner! As crazy as it sounds, Cliff Bordwell has never won PAX before. But now, he can check that off the list. Cliff put down some mega runs in his 1LE Camaro which bagged him 10th in Raw Time and that top PAX spot. Cliff credits those runs to some things he picked up from some guy named David Marcus. I guess he's fast or something.
- In AS, our 2020 and 2021 Tiger Champion, Mark Burt, took top honors. This continues his march toward a 3rd championship in a row. But, Mr. Robert Palmblad (winner in XS-B) is determined to make it interesting. And you can't count out Adam Arencibia-Moore (winner in CAM-T), who is also in striking range. Only 3 events to go and one more drop to be added to the equation!

- STR, even with 12 entries, is normally a very tight field. However, Ken Marion threw down a scorcher on his final run to take the win by 1.318 seconds

- In STU, Daniel Dejon came in with some serious AWD power as he and his Evo won over Scott McGlone by 3.228 seconds, and snagged 7th in Raw Time.

- In a nod to the future, we had not one but TWO electric cars! Mike Simmons in his Tesla M3P ran a very strong 37.589, winning the EV-X class. Vivian Liu put down a dominant performance in GS to win the class in her electric Mini Cooper! Now, some may say that they were the only ones in their classes, but what do those people know?

- Another nod to the future! Young Trevor Wells scored a win against his father Chris in the karts! Both of them ran their best runs on their 3rd attempts. The Force is strong with this one...

- In Novice, we had a stacked showing of 19 entries! At the top of the heap, by some margin, was Noah Propps, driving a 2014 335i Bimmer. Noah's time of 39.493 put him 2.412 over 2nd place Daniel Pelletier. It should be mentioned that Daniel showed up in a VERY nice 1988 325i that happened to have LS power. Per our own Chris Wells, who acted as instructor, it may have been the most well-balanced LS swapped car he's ever ridden in.

- While we're talking Novices, Joe Warner trophied with a bomber-spec, stripped-out machine that at some point in its life was a 2001 Acura CL Type S. It was hilarious and terrifying, especially as it lifted the rear tires off the ground during braking.

- And now for our August Cover Model! David Wallens became a member of our little club earlier this year, but he is a staple in the autocross community. You may recognize him from his articles in Grassroots Motorsports Magazine or just because of his awesome sideburns (jealous). Either way, David is always a super nice guy and even though he's a big-time celebrity, he hasn't once told me my writing is crap or I'll never work in this town again.
